General Rules for All Exhibitors

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season to be refunded with vet certificate from owner, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairman.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation.
*Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a Sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-to-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the ring/den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of a NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control his/her dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs, other than JRTs, on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655), or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA web site (www.terrier.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
23. THE JUDGES' DECISIONS CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!

An examination of the structure of Jack Russell Terriers

Cheryl Hart and Her Jack Russell Terriers

In 1989, I was in TX at a Quarter Horse Training facility when I met my first Jack Russell Terrier. I was visiting a friend and sharing some horse stories when her Jack Russell kept bringing me toys and wanted me to throw them for him so he could fetch. He then brought me a chew bone and wanted me to hold it for him so he could chew it. I fell in love with this little terrier on that trip to TX.

Bambi was the first Jack Russell to enter our home as a tiny puppy. Bambi was a Christmas gift for my son, Brad. Bambi was a “pud” but quite the little mouser. I then set out to find the “correct” Jack Russell who was purchased thru Dick Fenton. Her name was Candy Cane. Candy was registrable and was my first below ground hunting terrier who eventually became my first out of 31 Hart Farms Bronze Medallion dog earners.

I went to my first “fun day” in Kentucky which is where I met Ken Chambers who was a JRTCA Working Judge. Ken got me interested in hunting. After my first trip to Ken’s home, where Candy entered the earth and bolted several young groundhogs, I was hooked! My heart stopped when she disappeared but then burst with joy when I saw her do the job she so dearly loved. From this point on, I knew that the working terrier was going to be where I focused my breeding program.

I began going to some sanctioned JRTCA trials and enjoyed the events and the people who shared the love of the terrier that I did. A few years later, and for several years thereafter, I hosted the “Hart Farms Fun N Games” trial at my home in Collierville, TN. In 1999, I was one of the founders of the Magnolia Classic which I hosted at my farm for several years before it moved to Germantown Charity Horse Show Arena in Germantown, TN. In 2019, the Magnolia Classic will hold it’s 20th JRTCA trial.

For a few years, I enjoyed racing and showing in agility with a handsome boy by the name of “Charlie Brown”, who belonged to my son, Todd. Todd showed Charlie in the Youth events for a couple years (until the girls became a little more of a priority). Charlie was a smooth, 14” male that was a true all around terrier. He was also an exceptional working terrier who also earned his Bronze Medallion.

Approximately 20 years ago my husband, Mickey, and I chose to move to West Virginia due to the beauty of the country and the abundant amount of groundhogs! We chose to call our new home “Groundhog Retreat”. Needless to say, this is where many groundhogs have lived out a long and undisturbed life.

I was the secretary for a short period of time for the VJRTC and served a season on the JRTCA Breeders Committee. I became a working judge in 1996 and a conformation judge in 2004.

I have dedicated my life to getting new people interested in hunting and starting young terriers locating quarry and teaching them to be persistent and patient in accounting for their prey. I still whole heartily believe that if you start young dogs successfully hunting groundhogs, they will be successful hunting any ground quarry.

I have been fortunate enough to go to the JRTCA national trial for many years where Hart Farms Terriers have won many classes (Suitability to Groundhog, Suitability to Raccoon, Bronze Bitch class, Best Dog Family, Best Working Bitch, and Reserve Working Terrier Champion (Hart Farms Gracie).

Though this bio is supposed to be about me, the real tribute needs to go to my 30 terriers that have proven to me and to the judges that wrote their paperwork for them to earn their Bronze Medallion honors.

From Dallas:

Approximate Drive Time: 1 hour & 15 minutes

Drive East on I-30 for about an hour. Take exit 122 toward Cooper Lake/State Park, go 0.1 mi and then merge onto I-30 Frontage Rd and proceed 0.4 mi. Turn right onto the TX-19 N ramp and go 0.2 mi. Turn right onto TX-19 N/Hillcrest Dr. S and drive 1.6 mi, then turn right onto Houston St; trial site will be on the right after approximately 0.7 mi.

From Houston:

Approximate Drive Time: 4 hours & 30 minutes

Drive North on I-45 towards Dallas. Take exit 178 for US-79 toward Buffalo; drive 0.3 miles then turn right onto US-79 N/W Commerce St. Continue to follow US-79 N for 33 mi. Nearing Palestine, turn left onto TX-256 Loop W and proceed 1.6 mi. Take the TX-19 N/US-287 N ramp, drive 0.2 mi and then turn left onto TX-19 N/W Spring St. and drive for 30.3 mi. Continue onto TX-19 BUS N/S Palestine St and follow TX-19 BUS N for 4.2 mi. Continue onto TX-19 S for 66.3 mi. In Sulphur Springs, TX-19 becomes Hillcrest Dr. S; turn right onto Houston St; trial site will be on the right after 0.7 miles.

ALL terriers must be muzzled to race with either a plastic basket or close-ended cloth muzzle. To be eligible in the Championship, terriers must compete in both flats & hurdles. You MUST have your Jack ON DECK and securely muzzled in order to race. If you need help, please ask for it in advance. DO NOT wait until it's time to load into the starting boxes. BE PREPARED. Racing classes will be run in the precise sequence posted in this trial premium.

GO-TO-GROUND

A timed event that simulates the terrier's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. For all classes: work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work, if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Copies of JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging. Cross entering is not permitted between certificate classes.

- Class 42 Pre-Novice Puppy Go-To-Ground. Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for a full 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying)

If a terrier has passed the Novice Puppy Class or the Novice Adult Class, the terrier may not enter ANY Novice class ever again.

Class 43 Novice Puppy Go-To-Ground. Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JTRCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.) If a puppy has passed the Novice Puppy class, the terrier may not enter ANY novice puppy class ever again.

Class 44 Novice Adult Go-To-Ground. Open to JRTs one year or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 45 Open Puppy Go-To-Ground. Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 46 Open Adult Go-To-Ground. Open to JRTs one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning 100% MAY NOT enter the Championship Certificate Class at this trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 47 PUPPY CHAMPIONSHIP Go-To-Ground. Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 months, which have earned 100% in an Open Puppy GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached, must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES

No adult terrier may compete in any GTG Certificate class unless a Trial Certificate has been applied for, issued AND presented to the Trial Secretary or presented to the Den Steward at time of class.

A copy of the Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Over Adult GTG Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth, must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

SUPER EARTH

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier 6 months and older. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached and then must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.

Class 54 Puppies, 6 up to 12 months puppy super earth.

Class 55 Adults, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12½" super earth.

Class 56 Adults, 1 year and older, 12 ½" up to 15" super earth.

CONFORMATION

PLEASE REMEMBER TO EXIT THE RING ON THE SOUTH SIDE. SCRATCHES OR ADDS TO CONFORMATION BEFORE 11:00 AM EACH DAY!!

All terriers are judged on the JRTCA breed standard, except Child/Youth handlers where conformation is not considered and judging is based on the handler's ability. All terriers must be exhibited on lead. Cross-entering is not permitted between the Open Section and the Working Section. JRTCA Working Conformation is open to any JRTCA-registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate (NHC). A copy of the NHC certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or presented in the ring at time of judging.

YOUTH

All Child and Youth Handlers are invited to participate in our opening ceremonies promptly after racing awards inside the Conformation Ring. Then, Child and Youth Handler classes will begin promptly after opening ceremonies before the other Conformation Classes inside the Conformation ring. The Sanctioned Youth Division is open to JRTCA child and/or youth members in the following brackets: Child Handler (ages 5-9) and Youth Handler (ages 10-16). A child/youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the current calendar year except for those children turning five years of age; they may start competing in Child Handler any time of the year following their 5th birthday.

- Class 121 Child Handler.** Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.
- Class 122 Child G-T-G.** Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present

his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. If the terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before it can compete in Child Go-To-Ground. (Non-Sanctioned).

Class 123 CHILD HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE. (No entry fee) Awarded to the highest scoring and runner-up in classes 121 and 122. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th place = 3 points, 6th place = 2 points, and participation = 1 point. (Non-Sanctioned).

Class 124 Youth Handler. Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 125 Youth Working Judge's Choice. Open to any youth handler aged 10 through 16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.

Class 126 Youth G-T-G. Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. If the terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before it can compete in Youth Go-To-Ground.

Class 127 YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE. (No entry fee) Awarded each day to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in Classes 124, 125, and 126. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 3 points; 6th = 2 points; and participation = 1 point.

NOTE: Exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Youth Handling and Youth G-T-G to qualify for Youth Handler High Score & Reserve. In the case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the Conformation Ring; judge to be decided by the Trial Administrator.

AGILITY

Terriers must be one year old or older to compete in Agility. Fun runs (after Racing): \$5.⁰⁰ each, payable at Gate.

Jumpers/Games: Off-Lead. Consists of 12-17 jumps and/or tunnels with at least one lead change. Scoring is time plus faults, with lowest score getting 1st regardless of number of faults. Five faults for running course on-lead. Five faults for knocked bar, and off-course. Fifteen faults for missed obstacle. Qualifying score of 200 earns one leg toward a JRTCA Jumpers/Game Certificate.

Class 128 Jumpers/Games, Adults 1 year and older 10" up to 12.5"

Class 129 Jumpers/Games, Adults 1 year and older, over 12.5" up to 15"

Agility I Certificate: Off-Lead. Time 1.75 + 10%. Handlers may remain in this class. Open to any adult terriers. The Agility I Certificates are earned with three scores of 190 or above. Three qualifying scores may move entrant of this class on to Agility II, Agility III and Jumpers/Game. No cross entering to this class from Agility II and Agility III. No seesaw or tire jump in this class.

Class 130 Agility I Certificate Off-Lead 10.0" up to 12.5"

Class 131 Agility I Certificate Off-Lead Over 12.5" up to 15.0"

Agility II Certificate: Off Lead. Time 2.25+10%. More difficult course to include all of the Agility I equipment plus two more hurdles, weave poles, and seesaw. Qualifying Score of 190 or better earns one leg towards JRTCA Agility II Certificate.

Class 132 Agility II Certificate: Off-Lead 10.0" up to 12.5"

Class 133 Agility II Certificate: Off-Lead Over 12.5" up to 15.0"

Agility III Certificate: Off Lead Time 3.00+10%. Course to include all Agility I and II equipment. Weave poles are increased to 12 and must end in a "gamble". Qualifying score will be 200 points. Gamble to be set at 8 to 10 feet.

Class 134 Agility III Certificate: Off-Lead 10.0" up to 12.5"

Class 135 Agility III Certificate: Off-Lead Over 12.5" up to 15.0"

AGILITY HIGH SCORE CHAMPION & RESERVE. (No entry fee) To be awarded to the 1st & 2nd highest combination of scores from Agility II and Agility III and qualifying no fault score in Jumpers/Games. Ties to be broken by the fastest time.

Non-Sanctioned On-Lead. No cross-entering from these on-lead classes to any off-lead classes at this trial.

Class 136 Open Novice On-Lead Time YPS 1.50 - This class is for the true beginner, with the intent of a pleasant experience on the basic agility equipment. Handlers that drag their terriers around will be seriously faulted. Course to include ramps, tunnels, and various

hurdles. (Although this class is for the beginner, you need to have prior exposure to agility equipment.) No cross-entering from this class to any off-lead classes at this trial. Non-Sanctioned

Class 137 Open Agility Advanced On-lead Open to any adult terriers that have previously achieved a score of 190 or better in Novice On-Lead. Course the same as Novice On-Lead with the addition of the see-saw. No cross-entering from this class to any off-lead classes at this trial. Non-Sanctioned

RALLY OBEDIENCE

Rules follow Cynosport (APDT) rally found on rallydogs.com

Class 138 Companion Rally or Rally I "A". Open to any adult terrier. Performed on-lead. May be same course as Rally I. This class is for the companion terrier that has little or no formal Obedience training. A true beginner class. May not cross-enter Rally I or Rally II.

Class 139 Rally I "B". Open to any adult terrier that has a title in Rally 1 in any venue. Performed on-lead. Numbered course of 1-15 signs. Performed on loose lead at normal walking pace. Must have some knowledge of Obedience. May cross-enter into Rally II.

Class 140 Rally II. Open to any adult terrier. Performed off-lead. Numbered course of 15-18 signs. Course the same as Rally I with different or added exercises of more difficulty. May cross-enter into Rally I.

RALLY-OBEDIENCE HIGH SCORE CHAMPION & RESERVE. (No entry fee) To be awarded each day to the 1st & 2nd highest combination of scores from Classes 139 & 140. Most advanced class breaking the tie.

OBEDIENCE

Will use Companion Dog Sports Obedience Rules. Terriers must be one year old or older to compete

Class 141 Pre-Novice A Open to dogs that do not hold a Pre-Novice Title or dogs that do not showing Obedience in other venues. Not eligible for the Championship.

Class 142 Pre-Novice - B Open to any terrier that has a good knowledge of Obedience or hold a Pre-Novice Title. All commands on-leash. To be judged individually; heel, heel figure 8, stand for exam, recall. 1 minute Honor sit or down. This class is eligible for the Championship Class

Class 143 Novice. Open to any terrier. To be judged individually; heel on-leash, heel figure 8, moving stand for exam, recall over jump. Honor sit or down while you walk a "T" pattern. Eligible for the Championship.

Class 144 Open. Open to any adult terrier. To be judged individually; heel free, figure 8, drop on recall, retrieve on flat, retrieve over high jump, running broad jump, go out turn out and sit. May cross-enter into Pre-Novice "B" and Novice.

Class 145 Brace. Open to any two terriers. Two dogs performing Pre-Novice exercises together judged on Pre-Novice criteria. Dogs may be on two leads or coupled. Braces to be judged on precision. (The brace that works as one stands the best chance of winning.) Use one score sheet for the two terriers. 1 minute Honor sit or down.

OBEDIENCE HIGH SCORE CHAMPION & RESERVE. (No entry fee) To be awarded to the 2 highest combined scores in Pre-Novice B and Novice & Open. No entry fee. Most advanced class breaking the tie.

WEEKEND HIGH SCORING TERRIER – OBEDIENCE, RALLY-O & AGILITY – Perpetual trophy donated by Linda Knowles presented on Sunday. Award goes to the terrier with the highest combined scores totaled from both days from Obedience, Rally-O & Agility.

LURE COURSING, NON-SANCTIONED

This is a timed event in which the terrier chases a lure in an enclosed fenced course. Each dog will be running individually and there are two runs per entry. No experience necessary. You may enter as many times as you like, but only the first entry (best of two runs) will be considered for ribbon placement. All other runs considered as "fun runs". WEEKEND PUPPY LURE COURSE CHAMPION & RESERVE. (No entry fee, non-sanctioned) Open to puppies (6-12 months) with the combined fastest times for Saturday and Sunday will be awarded Champion & Reserve. Puppies must compete both days to be eligible. Award to be presented Sunday afternoon.

WEEKEND LURE COURSE CHAMPION & RESERVE. (No entry fee, non-sanctioned) Open to adult, veteran and senior JRTs with the combined fastest times for Saturday and Sunday. Terriers must compete both days to be eligible. Award to be presented Sunday afternoon.

BARN HUNT, NON-SANCTIONED

How fast can your terrier find the hidden rat? This is a timed event in which the terrier hunts for a rat placed in a ventilated PVC tube hidden in an enclosed horse stall or similar area. Watch your terrier look for the rat as he maneuvers bales of hay and other obstacles. You may enter as many times as you like but only the first run is considered for ribbon placement. Fun hunt: \$5.00, payable at Gate. Fun runs are not eligible for ribbon placement.

Class 155 Adults, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12 ½"

Class 156 Adults, 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"

Class 157 Veterans, 6 years and over

Class 158 Seniors, 9 years and over

WEEKEND PUPPY BARN HUNT CHAMPION & RESERVE. (No entry fee, non-sanctioned) Open to JRT puppies (4-12 months) with the combined fastest times for Saturday and Sunday will be awarded Champion & Reserve. Puppies must compete both days to be eligible. Award to be presented Sunday afternoon.

WEEKEND BARN HUNT CHAMPION & RESERVE. (No entry fee, non-sanctioned) Open to adult, veteran and senior JRTs with the combined fastest times for Saturday and Sunday. Terriers must compete both days to be eligible. Award to be presented Sunday afternoon.

TRAILING & LOCATING, SANCTIONED

The event involves the terrier tracking and locating a quarry (above ground). The terrier is judged on his ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate, mark and open on the quarry. The terrier is judged on a combination of time and accuracy. The terrier with the fastest time is not necessarily the winner.
