(ONLY ADULT GTG TUNNEL TIMES WILL COUNT FOR TIE BRAKER)
- Ribbons 1st through 6th Place & Champion & Reserve Champion Ribbons
- All entries must be pre-entries in order to have your infield passes mailed to you.
- **POTLUCK LUNCH (held after racing while GTG is open) Be sure to bring a dish!**

General Information

Enter through Potter Road-Gate 3. Gates open at 9:00 am

There will be NO tickets picked up at the gate!! You MUST have your tickets before arriving.

Due to the large number of people attending the steeplechase, expect traffic congestion so plan to arrive **EARLY**.

All cars must be parked along creek and around ends of race course. No tents may be put up.

Racing will begin promptly at 10:30 am. Go-To-Ground will begin after racing (short break) approximately 1:30 pm.

Bitches in season may not compete in racing but may compete in go-to-ground. Please go last in this event and carry her on the grounds.

Adult Schooling go-to-ground is for novice terriers that have never done go-to-ground before. The notice (or short) tunnel will be used. Adult Schooling go-to-ground entries may **NOT** cross enter into adult go-to-ground. **Ribbons will be awarded but no points towards Performance Champion.** Adult Short legged terriers will use the long tunnel.

Spay/Neuter terriers may compete in all events (according to height).

Adult terriers may not cross-enter between Regular Racing classes, Veteran Racing Classes and Senior Racing Classes or Go-to-Ground Classes.

No puppies under 3 months of age will be allowed at the steeplechase site. 3 month old puppies may compete in racing and go-to-ground.

No puppies for sale at the steeplechase site.

No dogs allowed on premise except those entered in races. All dogs must be kept on leash, crated or in a secure x-pen when not participating.

Entry Fees: (Make checks payable to CJRTC)

\$25.00 /person Admission to the Queen's Cup. Includes free infield parking.

\$5.00/dog which includes 3 classes: 2 races and 1 go-to-ground.

Children age 12 years and under get in free.

Queen's Cup Steeplechase Terrier Races

Racing will begin promptly at 10:30 am. No post entries. Entries must be postmarked no later than Saturday April 11, 2020. All terriers must be properly muzzled except for puppies under 6 months of age. **Please no brightly colored basket muzzles.**

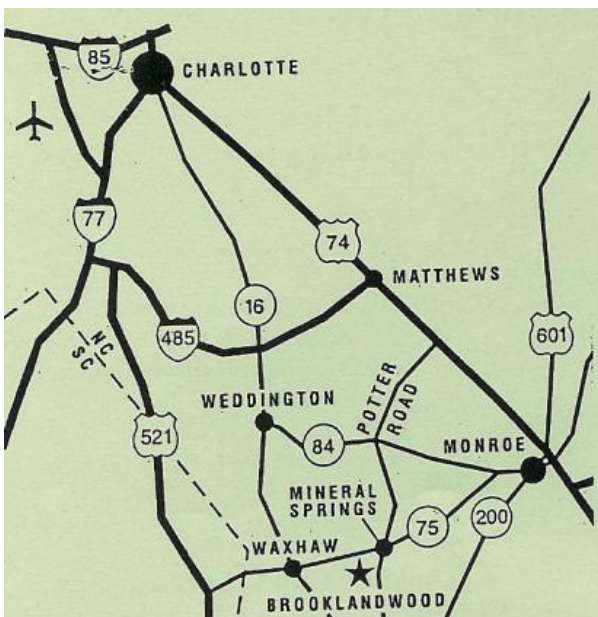

From Charlotte; Take Providence Road south (NC 16) until you dead-ends into NC Highway 75 at Waxhaw. When you get to the intersection of NC 16 (Providence Rd.) and NC 75, take a left onto NC 75. Follow Directional Signage. You'll run right into the racecourse about four miles down NC 75. As you enter the town of Mineral Springs, follow gate signs to enter the appropriate gate for your parking space. (Enter Gate 3-Potter Road)

From Monroe; Take NC 75 heading towards Waxhaw. When you get to Mineral Springs, follow gate signs to enter the assigned gate for your parking space. (Enter Gate 3-Potter Road). Follow signs to infield once you get into race course.
