Now in our 24th year, we are proud to present a trial for all earthdogs, which includes the majority of the terrier breeds and Dachshunds. Once again, we are happy to accept Purina Farms' gracious offer to host our trial. Enjoy the facilities and please remember to clean up after your dogs! We hope that all who attend will enjoy the events and companionship and leave with a little more knowledge and appreciation of our canine friends!

PRE-ENTRY: The pre-entry deadline in Trial Vault is May 20, 2022. The pre-entry postmark deadline is May 17, 2022. You are welcome to add classes, bump-ups, etc. during the trial. Entries received or paid after the deadline will be considered post entries. Pre-entry fees are \$12/class. Post entry fees are \$15/class. Pre-entries are required for Friday Night and Sunday Racing, Muskrat Racing, Jacks Are Wild! Poker, and Dutch Creek Challenge. No racing entries will be accepted after the pre-entry deadline or during the trial (except to fill heats).

<u>Trial Vault</u>: We are pleased to offer Trial Vault for entries and encourage you to use Trial Vault to make your online entries. The website is https://www.trialvault.dog and there is no cost to create an account. If you prefer, you can fill out a manual entry form and send to the mailing address on the entry form.

<u>Payments</u>: Payments can be made through PayPal to <u>payment@moearthdogs.org</u>. Please pay by Friends & Family. Checks (payable to Missouri Earthdogs) can be mailed to Tracy Flora, 1521 La Dina Place, Ellisville, MO 63011. Payment must be received by May 20 for pre-entry rates.

<u>Membership</u>: A Missouri Earthdogs membership is required to participate in the trial to satisfy our non-profit tax status. Individual \$15, Family \$20, or Youth \$10. To add your membership in Trial Vault, you can select from "Extras". If filling out an entry form, please add your membership.

<u>Certificates</u>: Our Working Conformation classes require a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate, an AWTA Working Certificate, a UKC Working Certificate or a valid working certificate from a working program for your breed. A copy of the certificate must be on file in Trial Vault, included with your entries or available for ring steward. If appropriate paperwork is not submitted, the dog will be bumped to Open. No refunds will be given.

Working classes: Because we feel strongly about the "working" part of our Memorial Day Bash, we have structured our Working classes to include other terriers. There is a Jack Russell Working Championship, as well as an Other Terrier / Dachshund Working Championship. The Champion and Reserve of each of these classes will move on to the Missouri Earthdogs Working Champion of Champions.

Working Ceremony: We recognize all Jack Russells, Other Earthworking terriers or Dachshunds who have received their JRTCA Bronze Medallion, JRTCA Working Achievement Award or AWTA Veteran Earthdog Award since June 2021. A ceremony/exhibition will be held immediately before Saturday's lunch break (approximately 12:00 pm). General Trial Rules

- Classes are for Jack Russell Terriers, Parson Russell Terriers, Other Earthworking terriers & Dachshunds only; except Lure Coursing, Barn Hunt, Brush Hunt and Tunnel Vision 2.0, which are open to other breeds (if they fit in a 9" tunnel),
- Parson Russells may enter Jack Russell classes.
- Other terriers and Dachshunds may only enter designated classes.
- ALL classes are open to intact and spayed/neutered terriers.
- Jack Russell or Parson Russell entries must be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard (with the exception of pups who have not yet reached 10" in height). Adults under 10" may be in Shorties classes. Measuring devices will be available.
- Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four month birthday (not 16 weeks) by the date of the trial.
- Bitches in season may not compete in any division and should not be brought to the trial site. Refunds will be provided with veterinarian documentation.
- Puppies under the age of three months are not allowed on the trial site or in RV camping areas.
- No puppy sales allowed on trial site. NO EXCEPTIONS! Anyone violating this rule will be excused from all classes, with
 no refunds, and asked to leave the trial site.
- Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number, or by the Judge EXCEPT in racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if the classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of any under adult dog entered in Racing may call for measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races). Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. JRTCA height cards will be honored.
- Excessive use of baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the conformation ring and may result in the terrier being excused. "Excessive use" will be at the judge's discretion.
- Entries in the Working division of conformation **MUST** provide the appropriate paperwork with pre-entries or have it available for ring steward. If appropriate paperwork is not provided, the dog will be bumped to Open. No refunds will be given.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no refunds will be given. "Unsportsmanlike" will be at the discretion of the trial committee/chairperson.
- Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control his/her dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the judges and/or trial committee/chairperson. Please remember that Purina Farms is a public place!
- Unclaimed ribbons will be available at the Trial office until the close of the trial on Sunday. No ribbons will be mailed.
- Please be understanding! Trial staff, volunteers, and winners of Raffle Butt Passes, will be bumped up in line at some events.
- The judges' decisions are final!

RACING RULES (See Muskrat Racing division for their rules)

- All entries must be muzzled. Only softy or basket muzzles are allowed. No figure eights or mikki muzzles.
- Exhibitors must have entries ready to race, be aware of their classes, and be ready when called.
- Heats will be run as listed on heat sheets. No refunds or reruns for missed heats/classes.
- Once entries are loaded into the starting box, all handlers shall proceed to the finish line to be ready to receive their dogs.
- In a flat or hurdle race, any entry not wearing a secured muzzle, going around the jumps, or jumping out of the racetrack will be disqualified from the race and therefore shown as not finishing that race.
- Races will be rerun if the lure is caught. In all cases, reruns are at the discretion of the judge.
- Entries engaging in fighting will be disqualified from racing for the remainder of the day. No refunds will be given.
- Entries must cross the finish line completely; the finish line is the back of the barrier. First *to* the hole is not necessarily first *through* the hole.
- Racing champions are determined by run-offs of the first place terriers in appropriate age and height classes. To be eligible
 to run in the Championship race, the terrier <u>MUST ENTER AND FINISH</u> both a flat and a hurdle race (reach the backside of
 the barrier) unassisted. A terrier that has not entered and finished both flats and hurdles is not eligible to run in the
 Championship race. In this case, the 2nd place terrier becomes eligible to run in the Championship race, assuming it was
 entered and finished both classes. Dachshunds must finish their Flat race (Championship) unassisted.
- Other Terriers & Dachshunds may only enter Other Terrier/Dachshund racing classes, except puppies. Parson Russells may enter Jack Russell classes.
- See General Rule regarding a size protest. Measurements must be requested and completed 30 minutes prior to the start of racing.
- No cross entering between Novice, Adult, Veteran or Senior racing classes.
- Novice racing classes are on Friday night only, 1-6 ribbons awarded, no championships.
- No racing entry may exceed 15".
- There is no entry fee for Championship Racing classes.

PPPIDC 2022 National Final

At this time, we don't know if Carson Events is going to include Jack Russell Hurdle Racing in the 2022 PPPIDC National Final at Purina on September 30 and October 1, 2022.

In the past, we have qualified 15 terriers to run with the 2 Regionals and the previous year's winner. Carson Events didn't have Jack Russell Hurdle Racing in the 2020 National Final. The previous winner was Hopewell Acres Blondie (2019) and, normally, she would be invited back by Carson and they'd have their two Regional winners. We are very hopeful that they will have the 2022 National Finals at Purina this fall and that they will include Jack Russell Hurdle Racing.

<u>Jacks Are Wild! Poker</u> **Pre-entry Only** \$10 entry fee per dog Saturday only Enter at the bottom of each dog's entry page in Trial Vault or enter class 273 on the entry form

You can enter as many dogs as you like. Each dog will have their own poker hand.

Participating dogs will receive a playing card for each class in which they are entered, including Sunday classes. You need at least 2 cards per dog. NOT TO EXCEED 5 PLAYING CARDS PER DOG!

The dog with the best hand is the Winner!! Jacks ARE Wild!!

If you enter multiple dogs, you cannot combine cards to improve your poker hand. Cards will be issued for paid classes only. You will not get additional cards if your dog is moved to a championship class.

If your dog is not entered in five classes and you would like to get additional cards, you can pay for additional runs at Tunnel Vision 2.0, Lure Coursing or Barn Hunt to receive another card or you can play fewer than 5 cards. Cards will be issued at the trial office.

To play you must pre-enter a dog in the class for this event.

Players must draw and report your poker hand, at the time of drawing, to the office by 3:00pm Saturday. At the end of the day **Saturday**, we will have a winner, after ribbons are handed out. 50% of all the proceeds will go to MOE and the other 50% will go to the winners: 70% to a "Champion" and 30% to a "Reserve Champion".

Division 2: Barn Hunt

May be entered multiple times, fastest time used for ribbon placement

In a simulated barn environment, can your dog find the hidden quarry in the fastest time? Only his nose knows for sure! Dogs of any breed are welcome to participate. Time begins when judge asks for dog to be released. One verbal command can be given at release; no other commands can be given until 30 seconds have passed. Judge will inform handler once the 30 seconds has been reached. Handler can follow terrier throughout the Barn Hunt area but cannot touch any of the props nor touch the dog. Once handler feels that the dog has found the location of the quarry, they must call time. If location is correct, then they will receive the time as displayed on the stop watch. If location is not correct, then the dog is disqualified. Once the maximum time limit has been reached, the judge will inform the handler that time has expired and dog is disqualified for that attempt. 2 minutes maximum time per dog. 1st & 2nd place winners in each class will be Champion & Reserve.

<u>Division 3: Child / Youth</u> **Entry Fee: \$5 per class

Child/Youth Conformation Judging begins at approx.9:00 am Child/Youth Meet Christin Giessman in Go-to-Ground area at 12:45 pm GTG Judging begins at approx. 1:00 pm

Section A: Child Handler Open to any child 5 to 9 years of age. To be eligible for High Point, must enter both Child Handler Conformation (class 55) and Child Handler Go-to-Ground (class 56) and handle the same dog.

- Class 55: **Child Handler Conformation** Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell/other earthworking terrier. Quality of dog NOT to be considered. **To be judged at 9:00am.**
- Class 56: Child Handler Go-to-Ground To be judged at 1:00pm. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of go-to-ground. To be run through a Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. If the terrier is entered in regular GTG, that entry must be completed prior to Child GTG or be disqualified.
- Class 57: <u>CHILD HIGH POINT CHAMPION & RESERVE</u> No entry fee Required entry in classes 55 and 56. Awarded to the highest scoring child and runner-up in classes 55 and 56.

Section B: Youth Handler Open to any child 10 to 17 years of age. To be eligible for High Point, must enter both Youth Handler Conformation (class 58) and Youth Handler Go-to-Ground (class 59) and handle the same dog.

- Class 58: **Youth Handler Conformation** Judged on youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell/other earthworking terrier. Quality of dog NOT to be considered. **To be judged at 9:00am.**
- Class 59: Youth Handler Go-to-Ground To be judged immediately after Child GTG at 1:00pm. Judged on youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of go-to-ground. To be run through a Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. If the terrier is entered in regular GTG, that entry must be completed prior to the youth GTG or be disqualified.


