GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

RULES FOR EACH EVENT WILL BE POSTED AT THAT EVENT

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10 - 15" JRTCA height standard (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed / neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier Classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the ring/den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC certificate signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.terrier.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial that have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
23. THE JUDGE'S DECISION(S) CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!

NOTE: No sale of Puppies at the trial site. No underage puppies on the trial grounds, including the camping area.

RACING

- A. All terriers including 4-6 month puppies, must be muzzled.
B. Basket Muzzles preferred. No open-ended muzzles. **No bright colored muzzles.** Collars should be off. No Baskerville Muzzles.
C. All terriers entering the catch area during a race without a secured muzzle will be disqualified.
D. All requests for height measurement must be made by 730 AM to the racing judge. Terriers will be measured with approved JRTCA wickets.
E. Other: Adult terriers one year and older, not registerable or recordable with the JRTCA. May not cross-enter into any sanctioned racing classes.
F. Terriers MAY NOT cross-enter between Adult, Veteran, Senior & Elder classes.

60 Child Go-to-Ground

Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. If the terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before it can compete in Child Go-To-Ground. (Non-Sanctioned).

CHILD HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to the highest scoring Child Handler and runner-up in classes. (Non-Sanctioned, No entry fee).

62 Youth Handler

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered. 65

63 Youth Working Judge Choice

Open to any youth handler aged 10 through 16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youths knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.

64 Youth Handler Go-to-Ground

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on Youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of GTG. To be run through 10 foot novice liner. Time not to be considered. If terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in regular GTG class before it can compete in Youth GTG.

65 Youth Handler Agility, Off Lead/On Lead

YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to highest scoring youth and runner up in classes 64-67, The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th place = 3 points, 6th place = 2 points, and participation = 1 point. Youth exhibitors must complete in a minimum of youth conformation and GTG to qualify for the child handler high score and reserve. In the case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the conformation ring, judge to be decided by trial chairperson.

Conformation

All terriers are judged on the JRTCA breed standard, except Child/Youth handlers where conformation is not considered and judging is based on the handler's ability. All terriers must be exhibited on lead. Cross-entering is not permitted between the Open Section and the Working Section. JRTCA Working Conformation is open to any JRTCA-registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate (NHC). A copy of the NHC certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or presented in the ring at time of judging.

Miscellaneous

- 67 Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier**
Open to any adult Spayed/Neutered Jack Russell Terrier, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. NHC to be provided with entry form or at time of class.
- 68 Spayed/Neutered Terrier**
Open to any adult Spayed/Neutered Jack Russell Terrier.
- BEST VETERAN TERRIER & RESERVE**
Open to any Jack Russell, 6 years of age or older. Judged on breed standard and condition of dog. Entrants spayed or neutered for health reasons not to be penalized.

Earthdog Conformation Non-sanctioned.

Earthdog conformation classes will be held after the sanctioned JRT conformation classes. Open to colored terriers (dark-bodied terriers with less than 51% white), dachshunds and any earthdog breed other than JRTs.

Go-to-ground

- Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. See posted rules at event.
- ***FOR ALL CLASSES:** work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work, if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself.
- Terrier is not to leave quarry once it is reached, for all classes.
- Must work quarry continuously for one full minute, without a break in work, unless noted.
- No Adult terrier may compete in the Championship Certificate class until the Trial Certificate has been applied for and issued and/or received.
- Please be courteous; let someone run between your dogs when you have more than one.
- Copies of JRTCA GTG trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging in all championship classes.
- Cross-entering is not permitted between classes.

105 Pre-Novice Puppy. Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds; without a break in work,* and w/o leaving quarry.

106 Novice Puppy: Open to Jack Russell puppies 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy class. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds; without a break in work,* and w/o leaving quarry.

107 Novice Adult: Open to Jack Russell adults, one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times; work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.*

108 Open Puppy. Open to Jack Russell puppies, 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial.
