Performance High Point Champion and Reserve Champion to receive the following: Performance Champion and Reserve in the following division: Puppy 3-6 months, Puppy 6-12 months, Adult Short Legged, Adult 10" up to 12 ½", Adult over 12 ½" up to 15", Veteran 10" up to 12 ½", Veteran over 12 ½ up to 15", Senior 10" up to 12 ½", Senior over 12 ½" up to 15, Other Dogs up to 12 ½", Other Dogs over 12 1/2" that will Through at 9" Hole. (ONLY ADULT GTG TUNNEL TIMES WILL COUNT FOR TIE BRAKER)

*** Note, All racing terriers, <u>including puppies</u> must be muzzled.*** Only closed end muzzles are allowed. No Mikki or figure eight muzzles*** Please no brightly colored basket muzzles

All puppies must be current on their vaccinations and no puppies under 3 months of age will be allowed at the trial. No Exceptions. No puppy sales at trial site. No puppies under 3 months of age in RV's. If you have young puppies, please bring a Stud Certificate to verify age. This will be strictly enforced. You will be asked to leave and no refunds will be given.

REFUNDS for classes will be given ONLY in cases of accident or illness of a terrier or owner, or for bitches in season. Situations must be documented in writing. Refunds provided by mail within 14 days following the trial.

Racing: Judge Bud Moomau

Racing will begin promptly at <u>10:00 AM</u>. All terriers including 4-6 month puppies must have "closed end" muzzles for racing. (Muzzles will be available on site for purchase or loan.) No cross entering between adult and veteran classes. <u>NOTE</u>: The track will be 250-300 feet in length with 4 hurdles. For this event, hurdles will be <u>LOW</u> for <u>ALL</u> age groups.

<u>Go-to-Ground</u>: All classes, except puppies, will be run in the 30 foot tunnel with three 90 degree turns.

- Class 32 Adults (10-12 ¹/₂ inches)

- Class 35 Veterans (12 ¹/₂-15 inches)
- Class 36 Seniors (10-12 ¹/₂ inches)
- Class 37 Seniors ($12\frac{1}{2}$ to 15 inches)

- Class 40 Adult Schooling Class. (Ribbons to 6th place. May NOT cross enter in any other go- to-ground classes)

<u>Thunder Tunnel Division</u>: Judge Emory Vaughn - This is a timed event with the terrier working their way through an above ground tunnel. One side of the tunnel is clear. Each terrier runs the tunnel twice and the better of the two times is the final time posted. You may pay at the gate but will be charged the post entry price.

<u>Conformation</u>: Judge Barry Magner – Jack Russell Terrier classes will be judged on the JRTCA breed standard. Open to Spay/Neutered terriers. *No cross entering.*

- Class 52 Puppies 3-6 months (open to dog & bitch pups at least 3 months old not over 6 months)
- Class 53 Puppies 6-12 months (open to dog & bitch pups over 6 months old but not exceeding 12 months)
- Class 54 Adult terrier (open to dog & bitch terriers that have reached 1 year old but not yet 6 years old)
- Class 55 Veteran terrier (open to dog & bitch terriers that have reached 6 years old but not yet 9 years old)
- Class 56 Senior terrier (open to dog & bitch terriers that are 9 years old or older)
- Class 57 Adult Dogs other than a Jack Russell Terrier
- Class 58 Child/Youth Handler (open to children and/or youth under the age of 18)
- Class 59 Companion (open to any spayed/neutered pet terrier not to be judged on breed standard but on pet/companion qualities)
- Class 60 Tricks for Treats (open to any dog that has a trick they can perform and judged on overall performance, not the level of trick)
- Class 61 Lurcher conformation judged by Tony Gammell.

Overall Conformation Champion Best of the Best: Open to 1st winners from class 52, 53, 54, 55, 56 & 57. (Child/Youth, Companion and Tricks for Treats not eligible)

Matterhorn Climb: Judge John Broadhurst. This is a climbing/jumping event with a terrier attempting to climb/jump up a vertical wall to reach a fox tail. Each dog will get two (2) attempts and the highest of each will be used for placement. The second time will be used in the event of a tie.
